



Great Salt Lake BA Jr. Gold Qualifier

Co-Sponsored by Big City Bowl (formerly Town and County Lanes)



1. This tournament is a scratch USBC certified competition and shall be governed by USBC rules. This tournament is open to all GSLBA bowlers with required average.
2. A minimum of six Jr. Gold members must participate for mixed competition; or six male Jr. Gold members for a male division or four female Jr. Gold members for a female division. If four females do not compete the mixed gender group will apply and those females bowling scores will be listed with the male scores and the two spots will be awarded to the two top qualifiers after the step ladder finals is complete.
3. Competition will take place at Big City Bowl (formerly Town & Country Lanes), 7980 S. State Street, Midvale, UT (801) 255-6866, with one squad time of 11:00am on January 17, 2010.
4. Entry closing at 10:30am on January 17, 2010.
5. A female is required to have a 150 or better average of 12 games or more as of January 16, 2010. A male is required to have a 175 or better average of 12 games or more as of January 16, 2010. For all Sport Bowling league averages, Rule 205 will apply. A standing sheet must accompany entry to verify all averages.
6. Two gold qualifying spots will be awarded.
7. The tournament format shall be 6 (six) games of bowling changing lanes after each game. Ties will be broken by a one game roll-off prior to the step-ladder finals. Should a tie still exist, it will be broken by an additional ninth and 10th frame roll-off. (Refer to rule 326a).
8. The top 5 (five) qualifiers in each division (male and female) will then bowl a one game stepladder final to determine the two winners. (Mixed competition will apply if 4 girls do not compete)
9. A sport shot will be provided.
10. Entry fee: \$30.00 (Lineage; \$15.00 and \$15.00 gold spot & shirt) Additional \$500.00 to be awarded by the GSLBA to the two premier spot winners (\$250 each). Town & Country Lanes will add an additional \$50.00 to each awarded spot. *Receipts are required before any funds can be distributed.*
11. A collared shirt and long pants are required as suitable attire. NO HATS OR LOW RIDING PANTS ALLOWED. No smoking or drinking of alcoholic beverages by guests or athletes on the concourse or in the settee area. Competitors shall be allowed 10 minutes of practice time on their starting pair. Missed frames shall be credited with a zero. Frames may not be made-up. A bowler not present to bowl when it's their turn will be credited with a zero for that frame.
12. Only bowlers and tournament officials shall be permitted in the settee area.
13. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament director 30 minutes after the completion of the competition. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the tournament director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing to the tournament director within 72 hours of the infraction. Under this rule, each protest must be specific in itself.
14. The two winners receiving spots will advance to the 2010 USBC Junior Gold Championships July 10-16, 2010 in Indianapolis, Indiana. They must be USBC Junior Gold members to advance (the advancer must meet the 175 or higher average for males or 150 average or higher for females) and have a USBC Junior Gold membership or purchase a USBC Junior Gold membership prior to or at the qualifier. A notice of at least two weeks must be given to the tournament director if a qualifying bowler advancing cannot attend the national finals. The spot will then be awarded to the next qualifying bowler.
