You must bowl (6) six games in the state seniors tournament to be eligible for the national seniors finals, you may bowl singles twice, or singles and doubles to acquire the six (6) games.

The (6) six game handicap winner in each age division will receive a paid entry into the national seniors finals.
 The date, time, and location to be determined later.

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament is open to all All bonified members of the United States Bowling Congress chartered local associations within the State of Utah, who have reached the age of 55 prior to the last day of the tournament. Non-UNITED STATES BOWLING CONGRESS MEMBERS WHO ARE RESIDENTS of the State of Utah will be eligible for participation upon application for associate membership and payment of appropriate dues (\$21.00). A resident is defined as one who makes their permanent home in the State of Utah. All participants are held responsible for the rule violations and are subject to USBC rules and regulations governing Tournament competition.
2. Handicap will be 80% of a 220 average.
3. Tournament will be in five classes: Super Senior 75 and up; Class A – 70 to 74; Class B – 65 to 69; Class C – 60 to 64; Class D – 55 to 59; years of age inclusive.
4. Bowlers age division will be determined by Bowlers Age of as last day of the State Seniors Tournament.
5. Entering Average:
 - a. Highest USBC certified book average (based on 21 games) for the previous season.
 - b. Bowlers with no average the previous season may use their current season average for 21 games or more as of Friday, October 28, 2011. If no current or previous year average, the Tournament Manager shall have the discretion to accept a verified certified average of 21 games or more from the previous 5 years to determine bowlers entering average.
 - c. Bowlers with no verifiable average will enter at 220 scratch.
 - d. All bowlers should be aware of average adjustment conditions of USBC rule 319d and/or 319e. Any Bowler whose average must be adjusted in accordance with provisions of rule 319d and/or 319e, must report such adjusted average prior to bowling.
 - e. Bowler's who have qualified for a prize of **\$600.00** or more in any event in a tournament within the previous 12 months, must report actual score, position, and amount won for possible re-rating. Such re-rating must be accomplished before entrant bowls. If not accepted, the entry fee shall be returned.
 - f. It shall be the bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average in handicap tournaments, whether originally submitted by the bowler or others. Failure to use proper average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average. Prize winnings will be based on submitted average if it is higher. Corrections in average can be made up to the completion of the first game of a series, or within 48 hours after completion of a series if the tournament manager, prior to completion of the first game of a series, has given written consent to the bowler authorizing such extension of time to correct his average.
6. Bowlers must attend the National Tournament to receive any expense money. If winner is not able to attend the National Tournament, the 2nd place winner may go and receive the paid entry and expense money.
7. Winners must provide verification of their age.
8. If a tie exists in all events, the bowlers will be declared co-champions. The bowler with the highest scratch Series in his all events Total will advance to the National Tournament.
9. Regular entries and re-entries will be accepted until the last squad of each event November 6, 2011.
10. Each consecutive (6) six games bowled (2 sets of singles, 1 set of singles and doubles or 2 sets of doubles) will determine all events score.
11. Bowlers will be eligible to cash once in singles and all events, and once with the same partner in doubles.
12. To be eligible to bowl in the National Seniors Tournament, you must bowl at least (6) six games at the State level.
13. All rules will be in compliance with USBC Tournament Rules.
14. **DRESS CODE: Full length trousers or slacks in good repair "non ragged, frayed or full of holes", shirts with sleeves, no tank tops, no hats, male or female (unless Tournament Manager grants a medical exemption).**
15. No entry money will be refunded unless the inability to bowl is due to the actions of the Utah State USBC BA.
