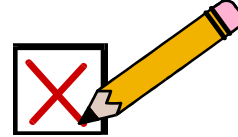

Tournament Rules

- 1) The tournament is open to men and women of the USBC.
- 2) The tournament takes place during the nights and time advertised on this flier.
- 3) The closing date for entries is the last scheduled squad. Bowlers may enter on night of schedule **if position available**.
- 4) **Participation rule:**
An entrant may participate in this tournament event 2 times. Bowler may cash 2 times, **but only once in the top five positions**.
- 5) **Average rule:**
 - a. Entrants will use their highest USBC sanctioned league average based on a minimum of 21 games for the 2008-09 season. If current 21 game average as of April 1 2010 is 10 or more pins above 2008-2009 seasons' average, current average must be used. If no average last year, use highest current USBC sanctioned average, 21 games or more, as of April 1 2010. All others bowl scratch. Scratch score that will be used is 230.

NOTE: Bowlers are responsible for proof of average. If no verification, Bowlers will bowl scratch.

- 6) Tournament is handicap. Handicap is 80% of the difference between 230
- 7) Bowlers will bowl **Eleven** games. Bowlers will receive credit for **Ten** Highest games.
- 8) Total pin fall including handicap will determine the order of finish.
- 9) In case of a tie for cash prize, the tied bowlers will equally divide the cash prize involved. The prize fund collected from each bowler will be returned 100%.
- 10) Tournament management will decide any question not covered by these tournament rules. Tournament management has the power to hear and act on all protests concerning the tournament. Their decision is final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
- 11) USBC Rule 319d applies. Bowlers who have qualified for a prize of \$600.00 or more in any event in a tournament in the previous twelve (12) months must report actual score, position and the amount won.
NOTE: Rule 319d is an optional rule. However, Rule 319d automatically applies UNLESS the tournament has a rule which states that bowlers need not report this information regarding tournament winnings.
USBC Rule 319e (unless tournament rules state otherwise) is applicable to all participants. A bowler SHALL ADJUST SUCH ENTERING AVERAGE, AND SHALL SUBMIT THE ADJUSTED AVERAGE TO THE TOURNAMENT MANAGER, if during the 12 month period immediately preceding the date and time of bowling (a) the accumulated average in all – but not less than 21 – tournament games exceeds such entering average by 15 or more pins, or (b) has bowled in 17 tournaments or less and he/she has exceeded his/her entering average by 20 or more pins per game in five tournaments or he/she has bowled in 18 tournaments or more and has exceeded his/her entering average by 20 or more pins per game in one-third of all tournaments – considering only the high series in a tournament. Bowlers required to submit an adjusted average will make the adjustment in keeping with the direction of USBC Rule 319e unless tournament rules provide that such adjustments are made after bowling
- 12) It is each bowler's responsibility to determine the submitted average is correct. Failure to use the proper average disqualifies score if submitted average is lower than actual, thereby resulting in lower classification or more handicap, or base prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher.
