Official Rules:General

1. This is an USBC sanctioned tournament. All rules not mentioned here are in effect.
2. All bowlers are required to be USBC members. If they are not they may purchase an associate membership for \$19.00.
3. All prize funds, guaranteed or otherwise, will be returned 100%. Prize funds paid at least 1 place per 8 entries; optional pots paid at least 1 in 10.
4. Entries will be accepted until all squads are filled as long as entry is presented 15 minutes before the squad being requested begins.
5. There will be no entry fees refunded after the tournament begins April 26, 2008.
6. No post dated or starter checks will be accepted for payment of any entry fee. Any returned or dishonored checks or money orders are subject to a \$20.00 fee and may be cause for disqualification.

Averages & Handicap

7. All bowlers will use their highest USBC book average for the '06-'07 bowling season. If the bowler does not have an average for this time they must use their highest current USBC/ABC average for the '07-'08 bowling season. If the bowler does not have an average for either these seasons they must use their highest ABC average for '05-'06 bowling season. If the bowler has no book average for the last two seasons they must bowl scratch. **NO SUMMER LEAGUE AVERAGES.**
8. If a bowler's current league ('07-'08) average, of 21 games or more as of April 26, 2008, is 10 pins or higher than their book average of rule 10, the current average will be used. 12. USBC rules 319c and 319d are in effect for re-rating of average used for handicap purpose.
9. **IT IS THE BOWLERS RESPONSIBILITY TO REPORT THEIR AVERAGE**, under the tournament rules, and verify that average at check in time. After the first ball of competition, any average discovered to be reported too low will result in a disqualification. Any average discovered to be reported too high **WILL NOT** be adjusted.
10. All handicap events will be based on 90% of the difference in the bowlers average and 230.
11. All bowlers not having an average published in the local USBC association average manual must provide tournament management with proof of average. This would include average posted on bowler's '07-'08 USBC card; copy or photocopy of bowler's local USBC association average manual; copy of last years final average sheet signed by league secretary with their contact information. **REMEMBER BOWLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE TO REPORT ACCURATE AVERAGE INFORMATION.**

Tournament Play

12. All bowlers should check in one half hour prior to their squad start time. Bowlers must have USBC cards (or proof of purchase) and all average information at this time.
13. Tournament management will complete lane assignment on these criteria: 1. First come first lane. 2. All entries received together will be scheduled together. 3. Schedule is subject to multiple participation, which may cause to supersede criteria 1. & 2. 4. Tournament management reserves the right to change the schedule at their discretion.
14. Doubles line-up orders may not be modified after check-in.
15. No pacers of any kind will be allowed in the tournament.
16. Late bowlers will receive a 0 for all frames missed. Bowlers should be familiar with USBC rule 322a 2 concerning waiting for a tardy bowler and USBC rule 322b.
17. Substitute bowlers are permitted. Substitutes must be declared to tournament management at check-in. Substitutes are subject to all tournament rules including average & handicap and multiple participation. Substitutes entering an event after it starts are subject to USBC rule 324b.
18. Scoring errors should be brought to the attention of tournament management or a qualified bowling center employee for correction. Any scoring error disputes must be brought to tournament management prior to any play continuing.
19. Doubles teams will bowl three games on one pair of lanes. Bowlers will be responsible for recording their game scores on the tournament recap sheets. All recorded scores are subject to USBC rule 327b.
20. In the event of automatic scorer or other bowling center machine failure; tournament management reserves the right to move bowler to complete play. If there are no lanes available tournament management may take any steps deemed necessary to complete play.
21. Ball weigh-in will not be required at the tournament, however, tournament management reserves the right to weigh, measure and/or test hardness of any ball they fill may not be in compliance with USBC rules.
22. Premature termination of this tournament brought on by war, national emergency or emergencies relating to fire, flood, labor, or any other disaster (natural or otherwise) not within the control of S & D Tournaments or Olympus Hills Lanes shall cause all prizes or awards to be prorated by the number of participants who have bowled in each event at the time of termination.

Optional Events

23. Any optional event must be entered at or before check in to bowling any part of the event.
24. Prepaid entries will be accepted for Optional Pots.

Other

25. All prize funds will be returned 100%. Any trophies, plaques or other awards (other than cash) will be purchased from the tournament's prize fund.
26. Any decisions made by tournament management on averages, handicap, scoring, interrupted play, optional events, dress code or any situation arising that is not addressed in these rules or those of USBC **WILL BE FINAL.**
